"Debussy Clair de Lune and Reverie Original Piano Edition" includes clearly notated manuscripts plus added performance and background notes and a concert CD of both pieces performed by Dean Mora. This French Impressionist pair of classic piano pieces deserves top recognition among music teachers and pianists. The edition is faultless. Also recommended in this series is the Easy Piano Edition of "Debussy Clair de Lune and Reverie (TS314, \$10.95)," which is transcribed and arranged for early intermediate pianists, also with performance CD.
